Prior to her new role at ITNCOASTALCT, Heather was Program Director for Alpha Community Services YMCA, which provides support to individuals affected by homelessness, mental health, and drug and alcohol related diagnosis. She has also done work with Project Return as well as Fairfield Public Schools with a focus on at risk youth.

Heather studied Psychology at Sacred Heart University, earning her Bachelor's degree in 2008. She has also completed a Master's Degree in Human Services with a focus on clinical counseling from Post University. She is a life-long resident of Fairfield, CT.
